STEM Scholars Class of 2023 received 108 college acceptances from 71 colleges and universities and over \$4 million in scholarship offers.

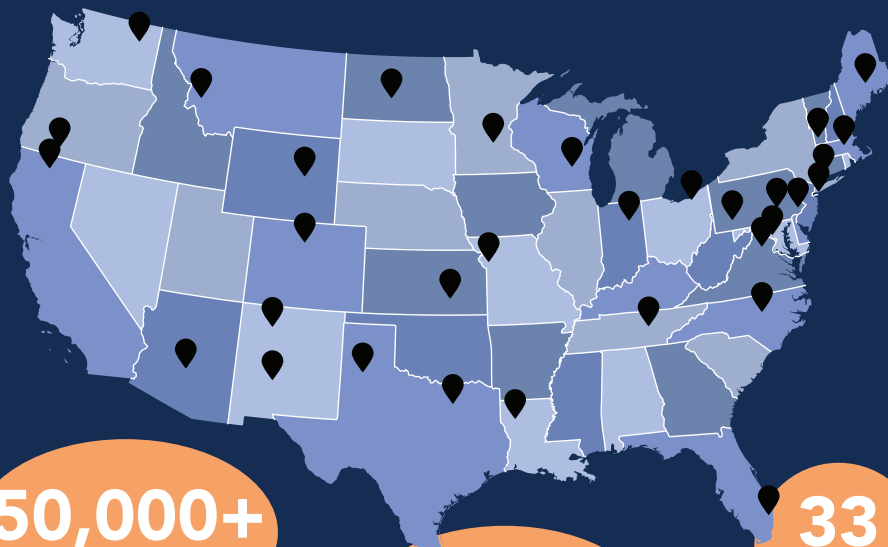
